

**Subject: Advisory MBBS (Final Year) pass out students who completed the 12-Months compulsory Rotatory Internship Training & having the Provisional Registration Certificate issued by U.P. Medical Council.**

This is in reference to the Letter No. MCI-23(1)/2020/Med./201867 dated 07.04.2020 regarding “[Advisory regarding Completion of 12 months of Internship by Medical Graduates commencing on/after 01 April 2020 in view of extraordinary situation due to outbreak of CONVID-19 Pandemic-Reg](#)”.

This is in concern to the MBBS (Final Year) pass out students who completed the 12-Months compulsory Rotatory Internship Training & having the Provisional Registration Certificate issued by U.P. Medical Council (UPMC).

The Permanent Registration Certificate of those candidates may be considered as issued by U.P. Medical Council on the basis of Provisional Registration Certificate issued by U.P. Medical Council and successfully completion of the Rotatory Internship Training with the condition that the candidate shall successfully receive the Permanent Registration Certificate by the U.P. Medical Council within the one-week period after completion of the Lock down situation arises by the CONVID-19 Pandemic-Reg by fulfilling the MCI/UPMC guidelines as below:

- a) On-Line Form Submission
- b) Photograph & Signature - properly signed and attested by the Principal of the Medical College
- c) Internship Completion Certificate (original) - properly signed and attested by the Principal of the Medical College
- d) Thumb Impression (At the time of Physical Verification in the office of U.P. Medical Council)
